5. Contestant must be accompanied by an adult to the location of the contest.
6. Each contestant will be interviewed separately.
7. The contestants must be on the location by 8:00 p.m. The pageant will be immediately following Tiny Tots.
8. Deadline for entry form and \$20.00 entry fee is Thursday morning of pageant.
9. Winners consisting of the couple will be expected to enter the State Fair contest in Louisville, which will be held in August. The required dress for the State Contest is age appropriate attire.
10. Each winner will receive a trophy and \$25.00.
11. Each child will receive a trophy and fair ribbon.
12. Any contestant that has competed at the professional level will be considered ineligible for this pageant. (Professionalism defined as follows: any contestant that has performed or competed for monetary gain) in anything other than amateur.
13. Entry fee for winners to the State Fair Contest will be paid for by the Lincoln County Fair Board. All other expenses will be the responsibility of the parents. Cash awards will be given by the State Fair and Kentucky Association of Fairs at the state contest.
14. Contestants are required to attend 10 a.m. practice on Thursday.
